Attention of all concerned is invited to the publication of this Institute's Advertisement No. 3/2017 whereby three posts of Technical Assistant and two posts of Technicians (1) were advertised.

In pursuance of the latest CSIR directives issued recently, the selection methodology for the above five posts shall be as follows:

**FOR THE POSTS OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANT [POST CODES 1,2 & 3]**

“The candidates as recommended by the Screening Committee will be invited for a trade test. Those who qualify in the trade test will be invited for a competitive written examination. The final merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained by the candidates in Paper-II and Paper-III of the Competitive written examination.”

There will be three papers (Paper I, Paper II and Paper III). Paper-II and Paper-III will be evaluated only for those candidates who secure the minimum threshold marks (to be determined by the Selection Committee) in Paper-I.

Following shall be the **Mode of Examination** for the said three posts:

<b>Mode of Examination</b>	OMR based or Computer Based Objective Type Multiple Choice Examination
<b>Medium of Questions</b>	The questions will be set both in English and Hindi except the questions on English language.
<b>Standard of Exam</b>	Diploma/Graduation level (based on the advertised qualification of the post).
<b>Total number of questions</b>	200
<b>Total Time Allotted</b>	3 hours
